Mill Road has recently been described as 'the new Islington!' Others still remember it as the route to the Workhouse. Take a stroll down Mill Road and SEE the Victorian workhouse! Discover the site of the mill that gave the road its name. See where the only steam locomotive manufactured in Cambridge was made. And hear about life in the recent past when children still slept four to a bed and the tin bath hung on the outside wall awaiting 'the weekly 'bath night' scrub. And journey over the bridge into Romsey Town to discover why this area was known as Little Russia'
